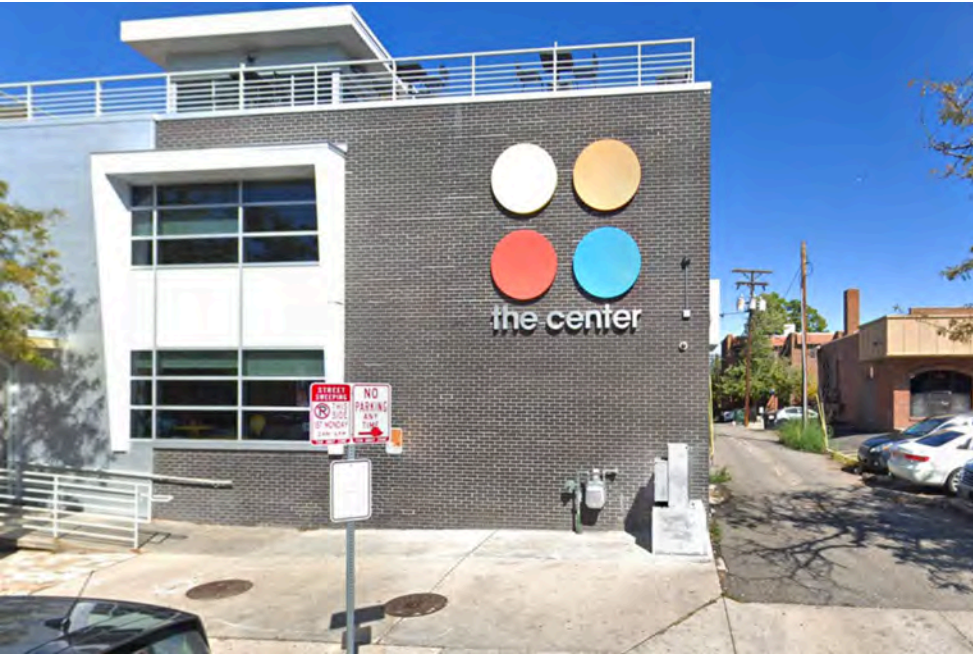
HEY DENVER

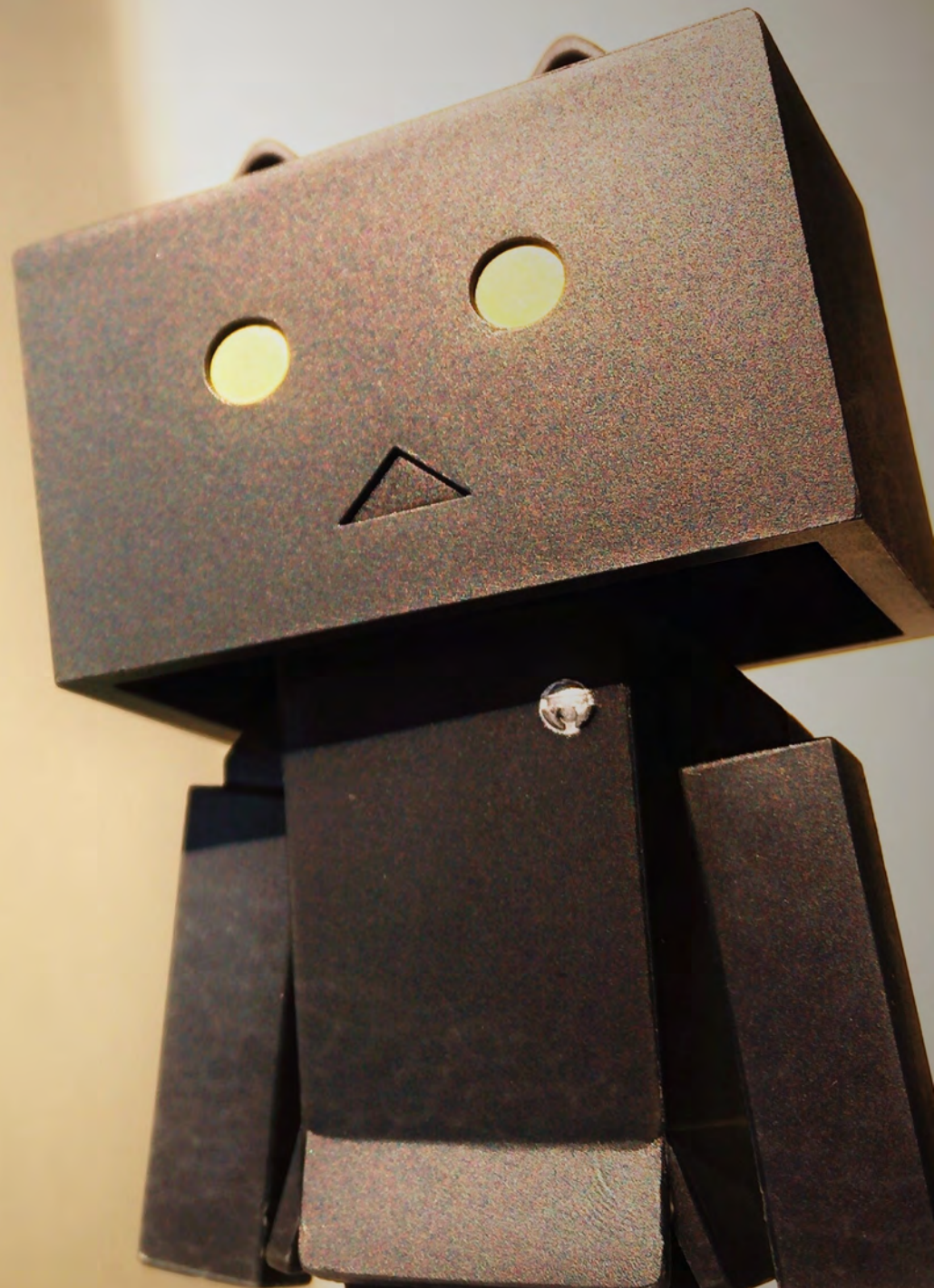




THE CENTER

EMMANUEL GALLERY

Built in 1876, the Emmanuel Gallery is Denver's oldest standing church structure. In 1969, the Emmanuel Chapel was approved for listing on the National Register of Historic Places and was also the first building listed as a historic site by Denver's Landmark Preservation Commission. In 1973, Emmanuel became part of the Auraria Campus –which includes the University of Colorado Denver, Metropolitan State University of Denver, and Community College of Denver. **It has since been remodeled for use as an art gallery and is managed by the University of Colorado Denver.**
